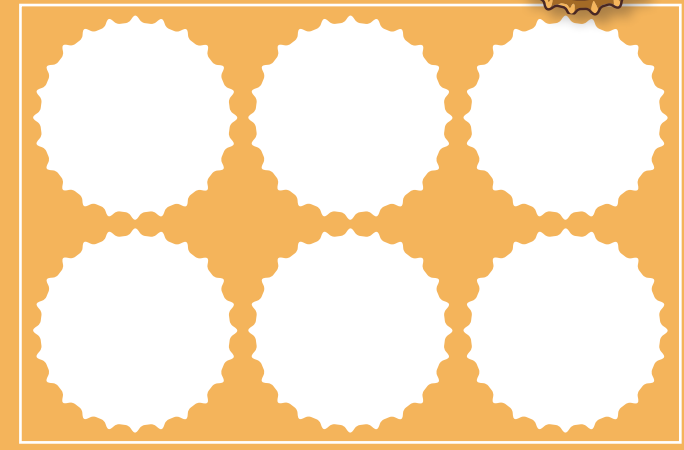

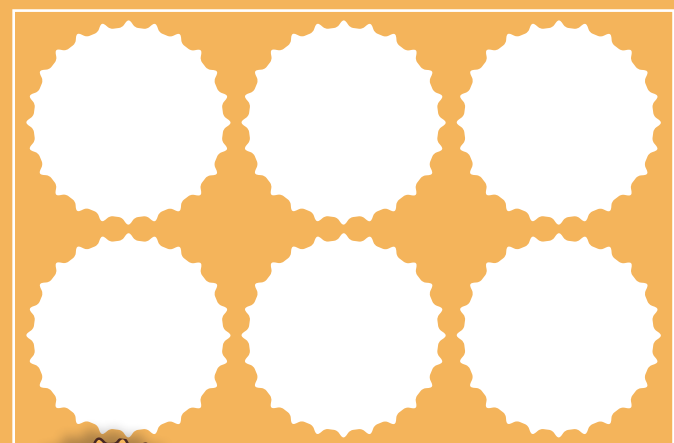

Old prints adorn the walls. The old yard serves as an outdoor drinking area. There is a skittle alley that doubles as a function room. Cobs, scotch eggs and pork pies available throughout the day.
